City of Baxley to Consider Opting Out of Georgia House Bill 581, Public Hearings Scheduled

BAXLEY, GA - The City of Baxley is currently reviewing the potential impacts of Georgia House Bill 581, which would limit annual property tax assessment increases to the rate of inflation. As part of this review process, city officials will hold three public hearings to gather input from residents before making a final decision on whether to opt out of the legislation.

Following the hearings, the City Council will carefully evaluate public feedback before making a final determination on whether to opt out of HB 581.
